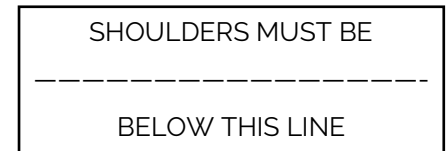
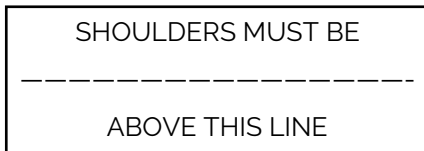
Restraint Laws: March 2010 Approx.

Rear Facing	0—6mths	(8kg min)
Forward Facing	6mths—4yrs	(18kg)
Booster	4yrs—7yrs	(26kg)
Booster Adult Passenger Seatbelt	145—155cm in height	

(Recommended by NSW Government Transport For NSW & Kid Safe Australia)

National Standards: Height Labelled June 2010

(All seats manufactured from November 2011 are all height labelled.)
